Before PUNCH, scientists could only see these storms for a small part of their journey. They had to guess the rest. Now PUNCH watches the storms nearly all the way to Earth. It takes a fresh picture every four minutes. That is a big improvement!

In its first big test, PUNCH predicted when a solar storm would arrive within just 30 minutes. One lead scientist called it a stunning result. He said it was like going from an old steam engine to a modern car. Scientists are very hopeful this tool will protect our planet for many years to come.
